Here is information about the online platforms we use at Creative Minds:

- PowerSchool is our student information system where you can check your child's attendance and grades. Information about using the portal is available <u>in this</u> <u>support center</u>.
- ParentSquare is our communication platform. In August, new families received an invitation to create a ParentSquare account. The ParentSquare app, for <u>Android devices</u> and <u>iPad and iPhone</u>, is an optional but convenient way to stay up to date on school communications. - Registering for Before School, After School, and Friday Enrichment requires you to register with our providers, Boys and Girls Club and FLEX. Information on registering will be sent via ParentSquare..

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Transition Week

The first week of school is a transition week for our pre-K3 students; the transitional schedule is optional for pre-K4 students. From Monday, August 29, through Wednesday, August 31, all pre-K3 students attend school from 8:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Students eat lunch in their classrooms before pickup. Thursday, September 1, is the first full day for pre-K3 students.

Campus Access Passes

All families must have a school-issued campus access pass, a requirement for entering campus, even if walking. **All families must request new ones.**

Families that submitted license and registration information with enrollment paperwork will have passes available to pick up at the front desk by August 25. If you have not already requested a pass through the enrollment forms or if you need additional passes, please request one <u>here</u>.

If your vehicle information changes—for example, you get a new car or update your plates/registration—or your parking pass is lost, damaged, or stolen, please immediately contact <u>frontdesk@creativemindspcs.org</u> to report the pass missing or to update your information.

Technology

Parents will receive a survey from us in late August to determine the technology needs of your household to ensure that your student has all the tools and resources they need for success.

Arrival and Dismissal

General

Please note the following:

- Creative Minds families may park only in Lot 5.
- Creative Minds families **must not** park at any time in the lot adjacent to the playground (Lot 2), the numbered school-staff parking spaces adjacent to the school (Lot 4), or any other Armed Forces Retirement Home (AFRH) parking lot.
- If your vehicle has handicapped tags, please use the drop-off lane each day.
- You may not park in the drop-off lane and walk your child into the school building.
- For the safety of our students, please observe the speed limit of 15 mph and all posted stop signs on campus. Reckless or inattentive driving will not be tolerated.
- The AFRH cites drivers and vehicles that do not adhere to parking and driving
 rules and is authorized to revoke campus driving and parking privileges; Creative
 Minds has no authority to alter AFRH decisions. Families whose privileges have
 been revoked must park in the neighborhood and walk to campus. Behavior that
 may result in a citation or revocation of driving and parking privileges includes
 the following:
 - Speeding
 - Not following directions of AFRH security personnel
 - Using abusive language
 - Leaving a vehicle unattended in the drop-off lane
 - Using of Eagle Gate to drive onto campus when Harewood Gate is open for Creative Minds families

Arrival

These are the logistics for morning arrival:

Using the Drop-off Lane	 Enter and exit through Harewood Gate. Pull all the way up and remain with your vehicle. Staff will assist your family.
Parking and Walking to the School Building	 Enter and exit through Harewood Gate. Park in Lot 5 and escort your child to the appropriate entrance.
Walking or Biking onto Campus	 Enter and exit through Eagle Gate. Proceed to the appropriate entrance.
Family Member Escorting a Child into School First two weeks of school only	Follow either the "Parking and Walking" or the "Walking and Biking" instructions to access campus.

Dismissal

Our dismissal plan is based on weather.

Students Walking Home

Some parents or guardians allow their children in 5th through 8th grades to walk home or take public transportation unaccompanied. If you would like to grant permission for

your child to sign himself or herself out of school in the afternoon, we will need written confirmation from you.

Creative Minds prohibits students who are not authorized to sign themselves out from using a ride-sharing service, such as Uber or Lyft. When using a ride-sharing service, these students must be accompanied by an authorized adult; the authorization must be on file in our student information system.

Early Release

If a child has a medical or dental appointment requiring an early dismissal, please notify the registrar at <u>frontdesk@creativemindspcs.org</u> and your child's teacher 24 hours ahead of time and provide supporting documentation. Students are signed out at the front desk, and the person signing them out must present a government-issued ID.

The front desk will not be able to process an early dismissal without previous notification, especially from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. If the front desk doesn't receive prior early dismissal notification for your child, you must wait until regular dismissal hours to pick up your child.

School Meals

Please note that Creative Minds is a nut-free school. Nuts and products containing nuts are not allowed on campus.

Creative Minds serves breakfast, lunch, and an after-school snack every day. We partner with Top Spanish, a local catering company, to provide our students with balanced, healthy meals and snacks as part of the National School Lunch Program.

- Breakfast is available free of charge to all students.
- Lunch is available for purchase. The cost is \$5.25 per school day. Families may qualify for free and reduced-price school lunch on the basis of income. For more information about this benefit, please see the section below entitled <u>"Free and Reduced Price Meal Applications."</u>
- Snacks eaten during the school day must be brought from home. Please send your child to school with a nut-free snack each day.
- *Snacks* are served to all students attending after-school programs. There is no charge for after-school snacks. Please send additional snacks with your child for the regular school day.

Monthly breakfast, lunch, and snack menus are posted to our <u>Nutrition & Wellness</u> webpage and in ParentSquare.

Free and Reduced-Price Meals Applications

Families may qualify for free or reduced-price school lunches on the basis of income or if they currently receive financial assistance through the District of Columbia government. You must fill out the free and reduced-price meals (FARM) application for us to determine whether you are eligible for discounted or no-cost meals. Families must reapply to FARM each year; FARM qualification lasts for only one year.

To apply to FARM, fill out an application in <u>English</u>, <u>Spanish</u>, or <u>Amharic</u>. The application should be returned to the front desk or emailed to <u>frontdesk@creativemindspcs.org</u>.

We urge all families that think they might be eligible to apply to FARM. If you are determined eligible for free or reduced-price meals, you will also receive discounts on our before- and after-school programs.

Selecting Meals by School Day We ask that families indicate days that their students plan to eat school lunch so we can estimate the demand. By the 25th of the previous month, a signup form for the upcoming month will be sent out to Parent Square (e.g., October's menu sign-up will be released by September 25). Complete one form per child per month. Use this link to sign up for meals in September.

Paid School Lunch

Students who eat lunch and do not qualify for free or reduced-price meals through the FARM application will be willed based on meals consumed. Payment will be made through <u>PowerSchool</u>.

Extended Creative Day Program

Creative Minds boasts a dynamic and inclusive Extended Creative Day (ECD) program FLEX (PK and Kindergarten) and Boys and Girls Club (1st grade through 8th grade). Students may participate in Before School, After School, Creative Clubs, and Friday Enrichment. A complete description of our programs, as well as pertinent policies and procedures, can be found in our *Student and Family Handbook*. What follows is a brief overview of these programs.

Before School

Prekindergarten-8th Grade

Our **Before School program** offers families the convenience of an early drop-off in the morning. Before School takes place between 7:30 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. Students attending Before School play games, read, and have breakfast before school begins.

Start Date: August 28, 2023

Monthly Cost: \$125 per child

After School

Prekindergarten-8th Grade

Our **After School program** runs from 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. and provides students with homework supervision, a nutritious snack, and free play, both indoors and in our outdoor playspace. Families may sign up for a monthly After School plan.

Start Date: August 28, 2023 (1st grade - 8th grade)

Creative Clubs

5th-8th Grades

Creative Clubs have been designed to allow our older students the opportunity to make choices and exercise leadership and self-direction. This program runs from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

The fall session will begin in October.

Monthly Cost: FREE for all middle school students

Friday Enrichment

We offer an enrichment program on Fridays when staff members have an afternoon of professional development. Enrichment activities include homework time, read-alouds, art projects, and math learning. Our ECD partner hosts the Friday Enrichment program.

Start Date: September 1, 2023

Monthly Cost: \$95 per child
